

## How to enter Score Sheet

Please follow the guide lines given in this document to enter accurate scoring. Scoring is very important for teams as well as the ACL. It will help ACL to choose the best players from your own team. ACL Score sheet has 6 sections and each section is described in the following sections.

### Section 1

1. Write the names of the teams playing on the top row of section 1. (Ex Team A VS Team B)
2. Tick the TOSS box, for the team who won the toss. (Ex. Team A, TOSS)
3. Tick the BATTING box, for the team who is batting (Ex. Team B)
4. If you know the Match Number please write it down if not you can ask Umpire.
5. Enter SCORER (your name) it's very important to get rewarded.
6. Please enter the date on which the match is being played.
7. Once the match is over please tick the WINNER box. (Ex. Team B)

1. Write the name of the batsmen. (Ex Dhoni)
2. Cut the number as batsmen scores the runs. When 2Ds,4s, and 6s are scored, Cut that many number at once, this will help us to identify the 4s and 6s scored by that batsmen.
3. HOW OUT – write the OUTCODES on top of this sections when batsmen get out. (Ex C)
4. FIELDER – write the fielder name who caught the ball. Ask umpire if you need the name (Ex. Cook)
5. BOWLER --- write the bowler who bowled the ball. (ex. Panesar)
6. TOTAL – Write the total (ex 50)

2. This should be your first place to enter the score, and then you can move on to bowler and batsmen.

1. Write the bowler name in the Bowler column.
2. Over 1 – 4 are for the same bowler in Bowler number 1;
3. Each box of OVER is for each ball. (ex. Over1 and Over2)
4. Use the codes provide on top of this section (0-dot, Y-wide, W-wicket, N-noball, RO-runout).
5. At end of the match please try to fill Wickets and Runs for that bowler.

1. This is the summary of the match for each over.
2. For each column (over), put the current score for that over and number of wickets fallen.
3. 0 if no wicket is fall.
